

Packet Circuit

A packet is a box containing books of stamps which belong to other collectors and offered for sale to members of the circuit.

Information for buyers-

The boxes are passed from one member to the next member on the list, usually at a meeting or by arrangement. You then take any stamps you wish to purchase from the book, signing the empty space and completing an enclosed form. When you have completed the box and passed it on to the next member you then send or give the form to the packet secretary together with any payment, there is no obligation to buy anything.

Information for sellers-

To sell stamps on our club circuit you will require a booklet which can be obtained from our club table or from most dealers. They are quite cheap to purchase. For club members no commission is payable on any sales, however we do accept books from non-members who will be charged a 10% commission and also pay the return postage.

The books usually take upwards of 2-3 months to complete our circuit, after which time they will be returned to you together with your payment. The club has insurance to cover them whilst they are on our circuit.
